

Texas Completes is a cadre of institutions comprised of over 35 colleges that educates 43% of the state's community college students. Members are managing partner Lone Star College (LSC), Alamo Community College District (ACCD), Austin Community College (ACC), Dallas County Community College District (DCCCD), El Paso Community College (EPCC), Kilgore College (KC), Odessa College (OC) and South Texas College (STC).

**Mission:** The mission of Texas Completes is to increase college completion rates in Texas through the utilization and implementation of high impact practices.

**Priorities:** Texas Completes will achieve the goal of increasing student completion through a commitment to 3 priorities:

1. Completion of a degree or certificate
2. Seamless transfer to a university
3. Entry into the workforce

**Strategies:** Cadre members deploy 5 main strategies to achieve the goal of increasing college completion:

1. Requiring a First Year Experience
2. Comprehensive advising and management
3. Designing pathways toward completion of a degree, certificate, transfer, or entry to the workforce
4. Redesign of developmental education to accelerate a student's progress to completion
5. Use of technology to support these efforts (Examples include: early alert, predictive analytics, e-advising, auto graduation, and reverse transfer data exchange)
